 - b) Chapter Enhancement- Even superior chapters have the ability to expand and advance their strengths to become even greater. We believe that a Gold Chapter, representing the best of the best, should constantly be taking steps towards not only advancing strengths but improving on weaknesses. This area could include service projects, internal chapter operations, or other goals the chapter has set to improve upon. We would like to see chapters identifying their weaknesses and then showing us in the video what they did to improve in this area with both qualitative and quantitative evidence.
