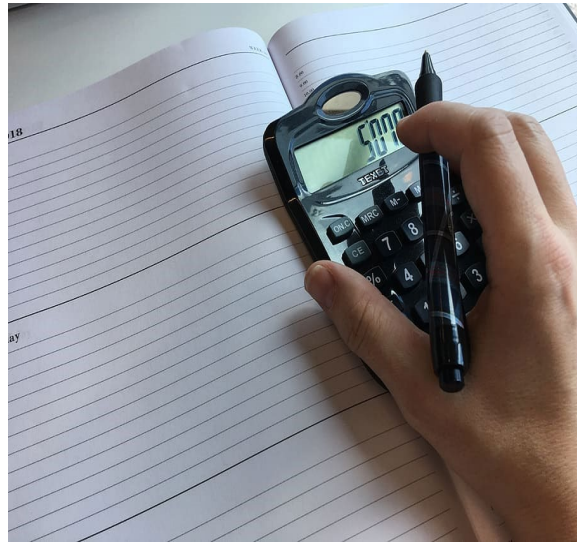

Tutoring

- Zoom
- 2 members, 2 candidates, 1 host
 - Host handles logistics
 - Members and Candidates tutor lower-level accounting courses
 - Tutoring is scheduled 3 days a week for 2 hours
 - Students sign up beforehand for tutoring assistance via a google sheet

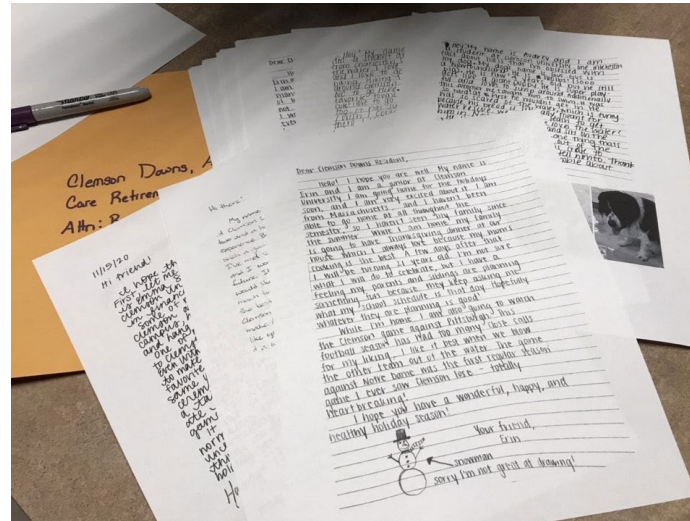
- Live and pre-recorded sessions
