In-Person Activities

Adopt-A-Road:

- > Our chapter oversees taking care of a section of road on campus
- > During this event, our participants will help pick up trash and do their best to maintain the road for our campus
- > 2 requirements before attending the event:
 - 1) All Candidates and Members must RSVP for EVERY Adopt-A-Road event they plan to attend through Knight Connect
 - 2) Fill out the University of Central Florida's volunteering form and send the confirmation to VP of Chapter Activities
- > Safety procedures:
 - Masks must always be worn
 - Social Distance Standards of 6 feet must be followed
 - All gear used for the program will be sanitized before and after use
- We had an average of 10-15 participants per event







In-Person Activities Cont.

Florida Breast Cancer Foundation Virtual Tribute Walk:

- The event is organized by the Orlando Sports Foundation, a non-profit organization, dedicated to bringing teams together to find a cure for cancer.
- > Where & When: Anytime and anytime
- ► Requirements:
 - Register for the event by a certain date
 - Walk for 1 mile
- > To receive points, send picture of yourself on the walk and a screenshot of the distance walked on a heal
- ➢ We had 47 participants

In-Person Activities Cont.

Beach Clean-Up:

- Location: Canova Beach Park
- > Date & Time: November 14, 2020 at 9:00AM
- > Requirements:
 - Arrive at meeting time
 - Prepared and followed all safety procedures
 - Actively participate in "cleaning the beach"
- > Safety procedures:
 - Masks must always be worn
 - Social Distance Standards of 6 feet must be followed
 - All gear used for the program will be sanitized before and after use
- > We had 7 participants

Operation Gratitude:

- A program that focuses on sending letters to first responders and people in the military
- In order to receive these points, the participants must show effort and care in the cards they produce
- Once completed, participants must send pictures of the card to VP of Chapter Activities
- > We had a total of 300 cards sent

Cards for Hospitalized Kids:

- In this program, participants will be creating cards to send to children in hospitals
- In order to receive these points, the participants must show effort and care in the cards they produce
- Once completed, participants must send pictures of the card to VP of Chapter Activities

Smithsonian Transcriptions:

- The Smithsonian has a program that uses volunteers to transcribe works of literature
- Upon registering, participants will select works of literature that they want to transcribe and will receive points for every accurately transcribed page
- In order to receive points, take a screenshot of the "My History" page, which illustrates the participants completed transcriptions, and send this to VP of Chapter Activities
- > We had a total of 275 transcripts sent

Individual Service Activities:


Clean the World
